## Do more, worry less.

Protecting your money is a top priority for us, that's why we're introducing two new debit card services to provide you with greater peace of mind.



**Text alerts** will notify you any time a debit card transaction is flagged as potentially fraudulent



transaction is flagged as potentially fraudulent or unusual based on your regular pattern of debit card use. You will be asked to verify the transaction to ensure legitimate transactions will be processed quickly and fraudulent

transactions are stopped before they affect your account.

Please make sure that your correct cell phone number is on file, so that you can receive text alerts related to your debit card.

#### After-hours debit card support is now available.



Call the credit union's phone number at **586**-**466-7800**, listen for the prompt for debit card support, and receive assistance for a variety of debit card issues. One great security feature of

this service is to report a debit card lost or stolen. This will allow you to protect your account further and prevent any fraudulent transactions from posting to your account.

These new features are additional ways that FreeStar Financial is taking the worry out of banking.
